Scalp Care & Hygiene

Proper scalp preparation is the foundation of healthy, comfortable braids that last. Starting with clean, conditioned hair prevents buildup and irritation while protecting your natural hair under protective styles.

Clarifying Shampoo


Removes product buildup and ensures a clean canvas for braiding, preventing future scalp issues.

Deep Conditioning

Adds necessary moisture and elasticity, strengthening hair to withstand the tension of braiding.

Proper Drying

Completely detangled, dry hair reduces tension and prevents breakage during the braiding process.



Apply a lightweight oil to your scalp after washing to create a protective barrier that helps prevent irritation while nourishing your scalp during the weeks your braids are installed.



Prepping for Braiding

Proper preparation prevents problems! Taking time to properly prepare your hair before braiding ensures smoother installation, reduced tension, and more defined parts.

Stretch Hair

Use heat (blow-drying) or heatless methods (braiding/banding) to elongate curls, making hair easier to manipulate and creating a more uniform look.

Thorough Detangling

Working with fully detangled hair reduces pain, breakage, and makes the sectioning process significantly faster. Start from ends and work up to roots.

Section Strategically

Divide hair into 4-8 large workable sections using clips or bands before beginning the braiding process. This organization prevents overwhelm.

Must-Have Tools: Combs

Rat Tail Comb

The pointed end creates precise parts and clean sections, essential for box braids and intricate styles. Look for combs with metal tips for the cleanest lines.

Wide-Tooth Comb

Gently detangles thick or curly hair without causing breakage. Use this first before moving to finer-toothed combs.

3

Precision Parting Comb

Creates ultra-straight lines and even sections for professional-looking results. The fine teeth help control even the smallest baby hairs.

Must-Have Tools: Clips & Accessories



Sectioning Clips

Alligator clips with strong grips hold hair securely during the braiding process. Invest in at least 8-12 clips of various sizes for maximum control.



Elastic Bands

Secure sections while working on others to maintain organization. Seamless bands prevent creases and damage to fragile edges.



Braiding Rack

For advanced stylists, this tool helps pre-sort and organize extensions, dramatically reducing installation time.

Essential Styling Products

Braid Gel & Edge Control

Provides grip and creates smooth lines at parts and edges. Look for alcohol-free formulas to prevent drying out your scalp.

Styling Mousse

Sets braids in place and reduces frizz throughout the life of your style. Apply lightly to avoid buildup and flaking.

Shine Spray

Creates a polished, salon-quality finish that makes braids look fresh longer. Adds UV protection to prevent color fading in synthetic hair.

Light Scalp Oil

Keeps the scalp moisturized throughout wear, preventing itching and flaking. Apply with a applicator bottle for precision.


